5. Notes for Authors

Publications

All the papers will be published in the Abstract Book of the Conference. A selection of full papers in electronic version will be published in the *Data Science Journal* and also on the CODATA international website.

Language

The conference working language is English.

Projectors

Overhead projectors and computer-aided projectors (for Microsoft PowerPoint presentations only) will be available. Mac computers will not be available for PowerPoint presentations. Mac users can connect to the computer-aided projectors if they bring their own computer and connecting cord.

Poster Display Board

Each poster presenter will be provided with a vertical surface to mount their poster presentation. The area available for the poster is limited to a rectangle 250 cm tall by 100 cm wide. Each board will host one poster, and it is recommended that each poster use the standard size of 120 cm tall by 90 cm wide. Poster materials must be legible from a distance of two meters. Lettering in text and figures should be at least 5 mm, and the heading should be at least 10 mm. The title of the paper, the authors, and their affiliations should appear near the top of the poster in letters approximately 25 mm high. Details for setting up the poster will be sent to you by the end of August.

9. Transportation

Arrival in Beijing:

Participants can make their own way to the conference venue by taxi. The distance between the airport and the Hotel is about a 30 minute drive. The note below will help you to get to the venue:

1. By Shuttle Bus and Taxi

You may take the shuttle bus from Beijing Capital Airport to Guo Mao (every 30 minutes, 16 RMB) and then take a taxi to China Resources Hotel (taxi charge about 16 RMB from Guo Mao to the hotel).

2. By Shuttle Bus and Subway

You may take the shuttle bus from Beijing Capital Airport to Xi Dan (every 30 minutes, 16 RMB) and then take the subway, Line 1 (3 RMB), to Si Hui Dong Station, which is then a 5-minute walk from China Resources Hotel. It usually takes one hour from the Airport to Xi Dan and half an hour from Xi Dan to the hotel.

3. By Taxi

From Beijing Capital Airport, take a taxi directly to China Resources Hotel. It usually takes 30 minutes and about RMB100 to get to the hotel.

Brief Introduction

Beijing, the capital of the Peoples Republic of China, serves as the center of politics and culture, with an area of 16 800 square km and a population of 13 million. As the capital of seven ancient dynasties, Beijing has numerous imperial gardens and a great cultural heritage, including the famous Forbidden City (Palace Museum), Summer Palace, Temple of Heaven, Ming Tombs, and Great Wall. Beijing is also known for its traditional handicrafts; Cloisonne and silk flowers are popular examples. Local dishes are dominated by Shandong cuisine and imperial flavor, but different cuisines from all over China are also very popular in Beijing. Following the rapid development of tourism and transportation in the last decade, especially as a result of its successful bid to host the 2008 Olympics, Beijing has now become a world-famous, modern metropolitan city.

Climate and Clothing

The temperature of Beijing during the conference period usually ranges from 18 to 23°C. The hotel and conference halls are all air-conditioned.

Currency and Banking

The Chinese currency is RMB. Foreigners can make currency exchange at all banks and hotels using cash and traveler's checks. The exchange can also be made by credit card using special ATM machine. The rate of USD: RMB is about 1.0:8.0.


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12. Map of China Resources Hotel in Beijing City
